



March 19, 2017: Human Rebellion

Adults: (Singles, College, Newlyweds, Empty Nesters, etc.)

1. What are some ways we are prone to distort or deny God's Word?
2. How is our mission in the world connected to the story of Adam and Eve's sin? How should this impact the way we share the gospel?
3. Name an effect of the fall that you see on a regular basis in the lives of others. How does the promise and appearing of Jesus give hope for this circumstance?

Students: (Grades 6th-12th)

1. Why is it important for our family to understand sin as rebellion toward God?
2. How can recognizing sin for what it is strengthen our family relationship?
3. In what ways do we see the effects of sin in the world? How should our family respond to the brokenness caused by sin?
4. How does understanding that Christ came to take away the guilt of our sin motivate our family to live for Him?

Children: (K-5th Grade)

1. What were the consequences of Adam and Eve's sin? (See Genesis 3:16-19.)
2. What are some ways that you have sinned?
3. How does Jesus help us with our sin problem?

Preschool:

1. God gave Adam and Eve a rule. What are some rules in our home? Why do we have them?
2. Are rules good or bad?
3. How was the world different after Adam and Eve sinned? (Life was painful. Work was hard. Adam and Eve were not close to God anymore. God sent Adam and Eve out of the garden.)
