



## March 26, 2017: The Spread of Sin

**Adults:** (Singles, College, Newlyweds, Empty Nesters, etc.)

1. What are some practical ways we can fight against evil desires that rise up within us?
2. Where are specific places in our community that we, as a group and a church, can slow the spread of sin?
3. How have you been impacted by the mercy of God shown to us in Jesus' blood shed for our sins? With whom will you share this good news of Jesus?

**Students:** (Grades 6th-12th)

1. In what ways has jealousy gotten in the way of our family relationships?
2. Why is it important for our family to model forgiveness toward one another?
3. How can holding one another accountable when facing temptation strengthen our family?
4. How well does our family model God's response to sin, not with fierce accusations but with an invitation to repent?

**Children:** (K-5th Grade)

1. What offering did Cain and Abel bring? (See Genesis 4:3-4.)
2. Cain sinned. What is the required punishment for sin? (See Romans 3:23; 6:23.)
3. How can your family bring an offering to God this week?

**Preschool:**

1. Sin hurt Adam and Eve's family. Does sin hurt our family?
2. God told Cain to be careful to control his sin. Name a time someone told you to be careful.
3. Adam and Eve waited for God to send someone to take away sin. Is waiting easy or hard?
