2. When Jesus redeems us, whose family are we adopted into? (God's family, Galatians 4:5)
3. How can you show God's love to someone in need?

Preschool:

1. How has God given our family what we need? How can we show God we are thankful?
2. Boaz was a family redeemer who helped his family when they were in trouble. Jesus is our Redeemer. How does Jesus help us?
