Adults: (Singles, College, Newlyweds, Empty Nesters, etc.)

1. What are some specific ways you will affirm God as King over your life?
2. How can we display our happiness and satisfaction in God in a way that helps others recognize their enslavement to “lesser kings”?
3. Write a prayer asking God to help you point a specific person to the King of kings who provides true happiness and satisfaction—Jesus Christ.

Students: (Grades 6th-12th)

1. Where do we sometimes place our security, other than in Christ? What are the signs of our misplaced trust?
2. How can our family prioritize the pursuit of holiness?
3. In what ways can we submit to God’s loving rule in our lives? What kind of difference will this make in our home?

Children: (K-5th Grade)

1. How was demanding a king the same as rejecting God?
2. Do you think Saul wanted to be king? Why or why not?
3. What does it mean for Jesus to be our King forever?

Preschool:

1. How did wanting a king show that the Israelites did not trust God?
2. Have you ever wanted something someone else had?
3. Have you ever gotten something you wanted and it did not turn out to be as great as you expected?
